1. Current activities of the Institute

I. Manufacturing –

Vaccines.

DPT group of Vaccines – With the creation of cGMP compliant DPT facility, CRI has launched TT vaccine in April 2016 and currently manufacturing and supplying DPT vaccine to UIP.

- a. **Yellow Fever Vaccine** – Although the institute does not currently produce Yellow Fever Vaccine, but the same is procured from international market and is supplied to various Yellow Fever inoculating centres across country for vaccination of International Travellers.

Antisera

- b. **Equine-based Antisera** – The institute is currently manufacturing life-saving antisera products such as Anti-Rabies Serum (ARS), Diphtheria Anti-Toxin Serum (DATS) and Anti-Snake Venom Serum (ASVS) in its old facility. The same is supplied the Government Hospitals based on their requirements.

Diagnostic Reagents

- c. **Diagnostic Reagents & Antisera** – The institute is in the production of various diagnostic reagents (Antigen-Proteus & Salmonella; Antisera- Salmonella & *Vibrio Cholerae*). Rabies diagnostic reagents (Challenge Virus Standard (CVS), F.I.T.C (Flourescent Isothiocynate) conjugates both liquid & Freeze dried, stain for Negri body slides & Normal Mouse brain (NMB) & Rabid Mouse brain (RMB) suspensions)

II. Surveillance and Diagnostics –

- a) Surveillance centres for Influenza, H1N1 and Zika Virus
- b) National Salmonella and E.coli Centre: National Referral Centre for Identification and serotyping of *Salmonella* spp. & *Escherichia coli*.
- c) Rabies Research Centre: provides diagnostic reagents & diagnostic facilities for suspected cases of rabies and also tests for sero-conversion for local as well as adjoining states
- d) COVID-19 testing lab: one of the public-sector ICMR-recognized labs in the state, has been established and is engaged in COVID-19 diagnosis in solan district. The institute has tested more than 80,000 Covid-19 samples.
- e) Institute has also COVID-19 sample collection centre.
- f) Institute is also COVID-19 Vaccination Centre.

III. Academics

- a) **Microbiology : M.Sc. (20 seats)** affiliated to Himachal Pradesh University it is the most sought after Institute for Microbiology in the state.
- b) **Post Graduate diploma in “Vaccinology and Immunobiologicals** affiliated to Himachal Pradesh University and the only type in the country.
- c) **Certificate course on “Production of Immuno-biologicals and Animal Care”** (50 seats) under the affiliation of State Council of Vocational Training (SCVT), Himachal Pradesh

IV. Training:

- a) **Industrial Training:** 08 different modules of training provided to students from different Universities and Colleges, pursuing graduate and postgraduate courses in Microbiology, Biotechnology, Biochemistry and Pharmaceutical Sciences.
- b) **Apprenticeship:** The Institute provides Apprenticeship to ITI passed student of various trades.


